

Regulations for Using the Ważyn Chamber

- 1 The Ważyn Chamber is an integral part of an underground tourist route where leisure activities, inhalation sessions and overnight stays take place. The Ważyn Chamber consists of four parts: a sports area, a cafeteria, a disco area and a dormitory.
- 2 The Ważyn Chamber is designated for both organised groups and individual tourists/visitors.
- 3 A stay in the Ważyn Chamber is always conducted under the supervision of the authorised personnel of the Bochnia Salt Ltd. (a guide or another employee in charge of tourist groups).
- 4 Schoolchildren and the underage can visit and stay in the Ważyn Chamber only under the supervision of adults who have custody over their children and take a full responsibility for them.
- 5 Guardians and people in charge of organised groups are obliged to cooperate with the salt mine guides in terms of safety and discipline.
- 6 During the stay in the Ważyn Chamber some facilities are made available to visitors, such as a playground, a salt playground/salt beach and a sports area. Their availability depends on the type of a visit or stay. Ultimately, a salt mine guide is in charge of which the tourist attractions are available to the visitors at the time.
- 7 Terms and conditions regarding the use of the facilities and tourist attractions named above (see a paragraph 6) are regulated by the Instruction and annexes, i.e. 'Regulations for Using a Playground in the Ważyn Chamber', 'Regulations for Using a Salt Playground/Salt Beach in the Ważyn Chamber' and 'Regulations for Using a Football Pitch in the Ważyn Chamber'.
- 8 The time of a visit or stay in the Ważyn Chamber varies depending on the type of a visit or stay and it is regulated by a guide.
- 9 During leisure activities and inhalation sessions following facilities are available to the visitors, a sports area, a cafeteria and a disco area.
- 10 The rules contained in 'Regulations for an Overnight Stay in the Ważyn Chamber' apply during overnight stays.
- 11 Leaving the Ważyn Chamber without permission, littering on the premises, skateboarding, rollerblading, cycling, entering the dormitory area without a guide (when the visitors and/or groups are not for an overnight stay), smoking, taking illegal drugs, consuming alcohol by the underage are strictly prohibited during overnight stays.
- 12 A tourist shall be liable for any damage caused by him/her. In case of schoolchildren and the underage the ultimate responsibility for any damage caused by them rests with their guardian.
- 13 Any accident and incident should be immediately reported by a tourist to a guide who is bound to administer first aid and immediately take appropriate measures described in 'Procedures of the guide's conduct in the event of the tourist's failure to comply with the Regulations for a Stay in the Bochnia Salt Mine', annex no. 6. to the Instructions. The guide must write an accident/incident report on the occasion.
- 14 Those who do not comply with 'Regulations for Using the Ważyn Chamber' (due to e.g. aggression, a state of alcohol or drug intoxication) can be brought by a guide to the surface.
- 15 Instructions, announcement and warnings issued by persons authorised by the Bochnia Salt Mine Management on the premises take precedence over paragraphs of these regulations.
- 16 A tourist takes a full responsibility for his/her valuables unattended and any damage caused by him/her to the Bochnia Salt Mine Ltd. or the third party. Ultimate responsibility rests with the tourist or his/her guardian due to non-compliance with these regulations.
- 17 The Bochnia Salt Mine Ltd. do not bear any responsibility for any damage caused by violating these regulations.
