

Regulations for the Overnight Stay in the Ważyn Chamber

1. A maximum of 236 people may stay in the Ważyn Chamber at one time during an overnight stay. Individual tourists are not included in organised groups. They stay in the Ważyn Chamber as a separate group (the date of the overnight stay is prearranged separately).
2. An overnight stay in the Ważyn Chamber takes place only under the supervision of the authorised personnel of the Bochnia Salt Mine Ltd. (a guide, a guardian of tourist groups).
3. During an overnight stay tourists can use the entire Ważyn Chamber which consists of the following areas: a sports field, a restaurant and a disco.
4. During an overnight stay in the Ważyn Chamber tourists have access to attractions such as a playground and a sports field. For an overnight stay organised for individual tourists an additional attraction is available such as a salt playground / salt beach.
5. The rules of using the attractions mentioned in paragraph no. 4 are regulated by the Instruction and the annex i.e. 'Regulations for Using the Playground in the Ważyn Chamber', 'Regulations for Using the Salt Playground / Salt Beach in the Ważyn Chamber' and 'Regulations for Using the Sports Field in the Ważyn Chamber'.
6. An overnight stay in the Ważyn Chamber takes place in the so-called a sleeping area.
7. The sleeping area is used as a place to sleep and is equipped with bunk beds which the guide assigns to participants of the overnight stay.
8. The beds are equipped with a mattress covered with a terry sheet as a standard for an overnight stay. Tourists who have not bought bedding are obliged to have their own sleeping bags. It is recommended to take a tracksuit for sleeping. Pyjamas type nightwear is not recommended.
9. During overnight stays there are lights-out from 1am to 6.30am.
10. During overnight stays only the person, to whom the bed has been assigned, can stay on it. Eating food and having shoes on while on the beds are strictly forbidden.
11. When staying overnight in the Ważyn Chamber leaving the place on one's own, littering the premises, skateboarding, rollerblading, cycling, etc., smoking, alcohol consumption and using other intoxicants by schoolchildren / the underage are strictly prohibited.
12. For any damage caused by a tourist the ultimate responsibility rests with the tourist or the guardian of the underage.
13. A tourist reports immediately every accident or incident to a guide who is obliged to provide assistance and takes action described in the document 'Procedures of the Guide's Conduct in the Event of a Tourist's Failure to Comply with the Regulations of Stay in the Bochnia Salt Mine' annex no. 6 to the Instruction. The guide is obliged to draw up an appropriate note under the circumstances.
14. Persons who do not comply with 'Regulations for Using the Ważyn Chamber' (e.g. aggression, alcohol intoxication or other intoxicants) may be taken by a guide to the surface.
15. Instructions, announcements and warnings issued by persons authorised by the Management of the Bochnia Salt Mine on the premises take precedence over paragraphs of these regulations.
16. The Bochnia Salt Mine Ltd. is not responsible for valuables left unattended. In the event that a tourist fails to be bound by the regulations the ultimate responsibility for any damage caused to the Bochnia Salt Mine Ltd. and / or the third party rests with the tourist (or his/her guardian).
17. The Bochnia Salt Mine Ltd. do not bear any responsibility for damage caused by violating these regulations.
